



## **Marc Margulies Honored with IFMA Boston President's Award**

The annual IFMA Boston Golf Tournament was launched by Margulies' employees in 1990 and the firm's marketing staff submitted the chapter's first winning "IFMA Chapter of the Year" submission.

Throughout this time, Marc Margulies has remained involved in the IFMA Boston chapter through his membership and sponsorships, and encourages his staff to become involved as well.
