

Architecture Firm Moves To 13,000 S.F. At Children's Museum

Boston-based architectural and interior design firm Margulies & Assoc. has leased 13,091 square feet at Boston Children's Museum.

Grubb & Ellis represented the landlord, Boston Children's Museum, in the transaction. Margulies & Assoc. was represented by CB Richard Ellis.

Margulies & Assoc. was previously headquartered at 234 Congress St. in the Financial District, where it occupied approximately 12,000 square feet over three floors. The firm has increased its office space and will occupy a portion of the fourth floor of Boston Children's Museum; with the museum occupying the first three.
