Margulies Perruzzi Architects was recently honored for its use of clay brick in the new, 329,000-square-foot office building the firm designed for Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts.

The award, called the Brick in Architecture Awards sponsored by the Brick Industry Association, is the fifth the building, which was developed by A.W. Perry Inc., has received.

Located in Hingham, the four-story building includes a cafeteria, conference/training center, data center, child care facility and a five-level, 1,184-space parking garage. There are about 1,100 people working in the facility, which features clay brick in the interior of the building. Located at 25 Technology Place and completed in June 2007, the building is the region's largest LEED silver certified project.
