



Margulies Perruzzi redesigns Fiduciary's Boston office

The office space of Fiduciary Trust Company in Boston, Massachusetts, has received a makeover, following renovation and redesign by Massachusetts-based architecture and interior design firm, Margulies Perruzzi.

The renovated office interior features hardwood and glass with a blue color palette. The modernized look comes via high-efficiency, indirect lighting with the additional benefits of ease eyestrain for employees, and energy savings for the building.

An existing open staircase between the reception area and the floor above got a refreshed look with the incorporation of dark wood and glass.

The re-configured space features 93 workstations and 65 offices around the perimeter. Patterned glass on the sidelights of office doors makes the space brighter along with maintaining office privacy.

Fiduciary Trust Company occupied 45,000 square feet in three and a half floors of Fiduciary Trust Building since 1977 and the company had been considering the option of finding a new space or staying and renovating its existing office space.

Margulies Perruzzi conducted several test fits in buildings around Boston and helped them in their decision making process. After considering the pros and cons of different options, Fiduciary has decided to stay in its existing location and modernize its space.
